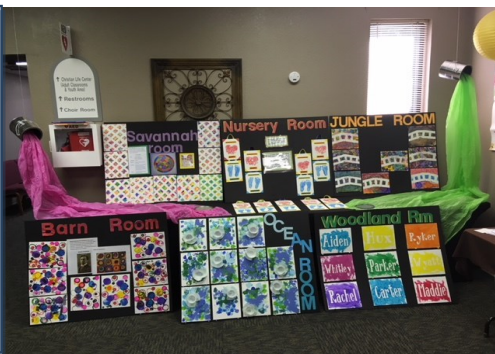


PUMPKINS FOR SALE!

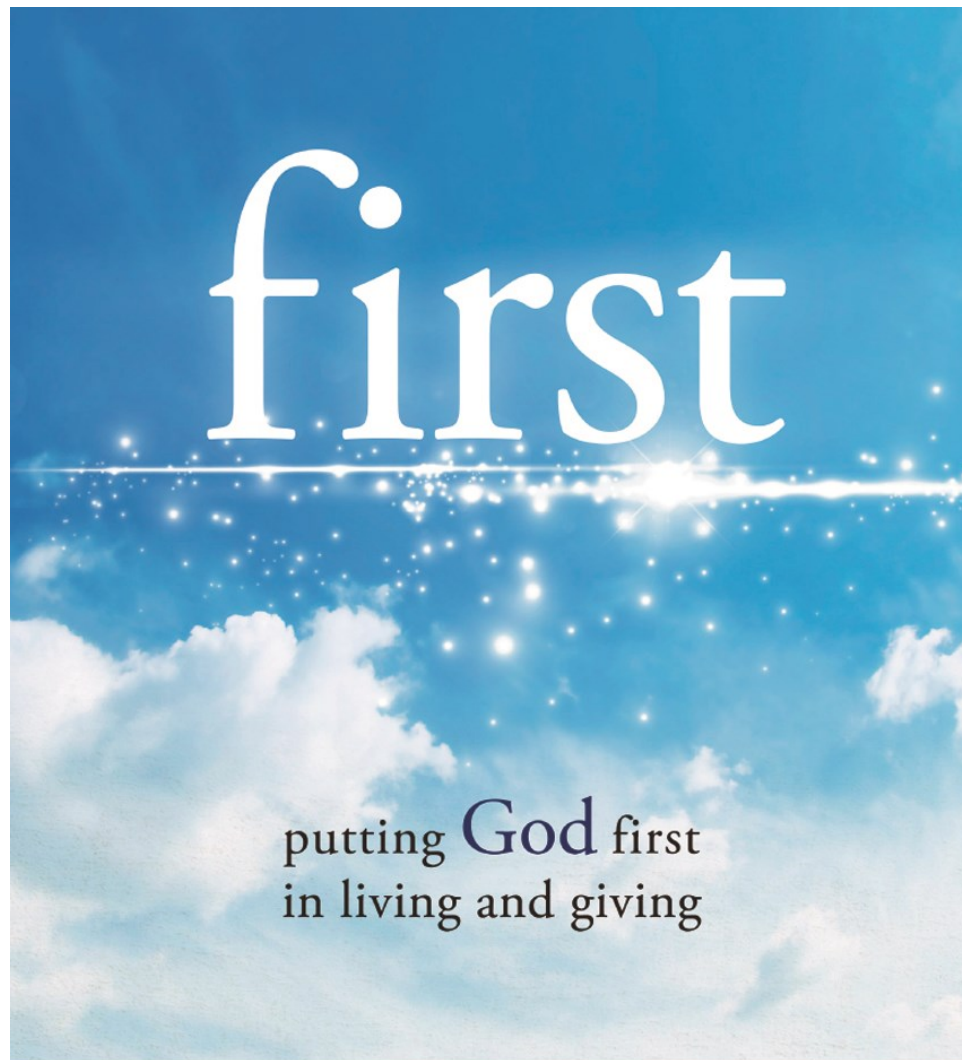
